- **\$25.00 entry fee** (allows up to four team members entry to the festival)—**prize money of \$200.00 / \$100.00 / \$75.00** for first, second, and third place teams.
- Two full racks of ribs will need to be cooked and submitted for judging. A **pork rib entry** is defined by Memphis Barbecue Network as the portion of the hog containing the ribs and further classified as a spare rib or loin rib portion—generally St. Louis or baby back ribs. Country style ribs **are not** a valid entry.
- Barbecue is defined by Memphis Barbecue Network as pork meat, **fresh or frozen and uncured**, prepared **only on a wood and/or charcoal fire**, with any consumable substances and sauces as the cook believes necessary.
- Other flammable materials (propane, compressed or liquid gas) may be used to start the fire.
- **Uncooked and untreated** ribs will be inspected Saturday morning prior to the competition.
- **Meat inspection** between 7:00-8:00 a.m. Saturday. There will be a **mandatory cooks' meeting** at 8:00 a.m. **Setup and cooking** can begin anytime after 7:00 a.m., with **judging** to commence at 2:30 p.m.
- All judging done by trained judges in a blind-judging format comparing your entries in four categories: **Appearance of Entry, Tenderness of Entry, Flavor and Overall Impression**
